Spring has sprung!

It's time for Spring cleaning & planting.

Spring is a hopeful season, and a little preparation goes a long way. Before planting, loosen compacted soil and mix in compost to improve drainage and root growth. Be patient—wait until the risk of frost has passed to protect young plants.

Choose plants suited to the season. Cool-weather options like lettuce, peas, and pansies do well early, while warm-season plants thrive once temperatures rise. Most vegetables and flowers need at least six hours of sunlight daily. Water gently and regularly as plants establish.



Above all, enjoy the process. Whether it's a full garden or a few containers, spring planting is a rewarding way to connect with nature. Happy growing!

Let's make sure our yards are in tip-top shape by:

- Keeping yards free from debris and trash.
- Ensuring that trash cans are not visible from the front of your house (per covenants).
- Keeping up with repairs in yards like fences, lamp posts, and mailboxes.
- Keeping lawns mowed.
- Keep your yard weed and dandelion free.
- Please note –political signs are not permitted in yards.

Tax Season:

Tax season is prime time for scams – beware of emails or calls claiming to be from the IRS. Key point to watch – anything demanding immediate payment or threats of arrest. Check out the IRS Website for more info:

Neighborhood Updates

Fraud case:

The treasurer chose to pay half the money that was stolen, \$2400. It's still an open case with law enforcement.

Procedural Changes

To minimize chances of fraud, expenditures other than our normal bills that are on autopay will require approval of the board as a check and balance.

We are also looking for anyone interested in being treasurer– please contact a board member if you are interested.

Snow Removal:

We understand everyone's frustration with the snow removal from the last big snow, and we plan on having a meeting with Green Gang about future snow removal expectations.

We did get another estimate for snow removal, which feels cost-prohibitive - \$2000 min.

Dues

Dues for 2026 increased to \$425. If you haven't paid yet, please send soon. A late fee of \$25 per month began on April 1st. Remember, you have the option of paying half (212.50) now and the other half in September.
